Covid Ongoing Safety

Due to poor ventilation, you are very welcome to continue to wear masks in the church. We would ask that you do this, if you are feeling unwell or know that you will be with someone who may be vulnerable. We are also now sharing the common cup, but please be aware that **this involves a transmission risk**, which cannot be mitigated against. Just because the Common Cup is now available, does not mean that you have to share it. Communion is equally valid in one kind only, and there is no pressure or judgement around your personal choice in this matter. If you are vulnerable or concerned, Revd Lizzie would encourage a cautious approach to this offering. Additionally, we are relying on your integrity **not to take from the chalice if you are feeling unwell in any way**. If you wish to share, having received the bread, move away from Revd Lizzie to consume it, and make your way to the chalice bearer who will administer the cup. Please do not touch the chalice and **under no circumstances can bread be intincted** (dipped) into the wine.

Revd Lizzie is once again preaching from the pulpit. As she will not be wearing a mask due to practicality issues, if you are at all concerned about the transmission of Covid, you may wish to refrain from sitting in the seats directly below the pulpit.
